

Friendly Area Neighbors - Radio Ready Plan Basics

Keep with your radio, or post at home, in office, or by your electrical panel

All of Friendly Area is in Eugene Evacuation Zone 23

In an Emergency Event: Secure the safety of yourself, family and home first, before volunteering.

- Listen to local emergency broadcast stations: **KLCC 89.7 FM / KPNW 1120 AM / KUGN 590 AM**
- Tune to a NOAA weather channel; in a two-way radio or on a NOAA Weather Alert Radio, if indicated.
- Listen to FRS/GMRS **Channel 6**, and/or FAN Ham frequency listed below, **at the beginning of each hour for 5-10 minutes**. Spare your batteries.
- Check the Slack FAN-Radio #announcement channel for activation notices. (Radio Ready volunteers)
- Be Safe. Work with a partner. Check in with a team leader at least every 30 minutes while active.
- If Activated, notify your team leader or Net Control before turning off your radio, or if you are unavailable.

Radio Ready Monthly Second Sunday Net Practice

FRS/GMRS: Starts at 6 pm on Channel 6

Ham Net: Starts at 6:30 pm, or following the FRS Net, on 145.45 MHz, PL tone 123 Hz, -600 KHz offset

Channels are subject to change based on activity or availability

* Channel 6 is the primary one for Friendly Area Neighbors (FAN). If it's busy, we go to Channel 20. The FRS Channel 6 frequency is 462.6875, where hams may **listen only**, but not transmit.

(Primary) 145.45 MHz, Tone 123, -.600 offset (W7ARD Blanton Heights repeater).

(Secondary) 146.50 Simplex - Alternate Frequency for FAN Radio Ready Hams

446.050 MHz Simplex CERT SE Dist. 2 ↔ Neighborhood Ham Base

146.880 Tone 100 Eugene EOC ↔ CERT SE Dist 2 and other CERT District Stations

147.460 Simplex City EOC ↔ CERT District Stations

FAN is located in CERT SE District 2, along with four other chartered neighborhood associations: Downtown, Jefferson-Westside, West University, and Whiteaker Community Council.
