

Eugene EmComm - Zoom Night Script

146.880 MHz 100 Hz Tone

Alternate 147.46 Simplex

1. This is [CALLSIGN]. QRL, QRL. Is this frequency in use? Is this frequency in use? This is [CALLSIGN].
2. Good evening, everyone. This is [NAME], [CALLSIGN in ITU PHONETICS] in [YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD], Net Control Operator for this evening's session of the Eugene Emergency Communications Network.
3. On the first, second, third and fifth Wednesday of each month we hold a network on frequency **146.880 MHz** with a 100 Hz Tone, with an Alternate frequency of **147.46 MHz Simplex**. On these evenings the net occurs from 7 to 8 PM.
4. On the fourth Wednesday of each month, such as this evening, our regularly scheduled net is replaced by an online Zoom training session. A link for the Zoom session is available at EugeneEmComm.org. [*pause*]
5. All stations are encouraged to join the online Zoom session this evening. Checking in on-air is not required for these sessions. If you wish to check in, or have questions regarding this evening's program, you will have the opportunity after this introduction.
6. This is [NAME], [CALLSIGN] in [YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD], Net Control for this evening. If you wish to be recognized, please check in now with your call sign using ITU phonetics, your name, and your geographical location. Once you are recognized, you no longer need to use ITU phonetics. [*pause, take check-ins and questions*]

8. Hearing nothing further, I wish to thank everyone who checked in to tonight's Eugene EmComm net, and I encourage you to join us immediately following this on-air session for the online Zoom training. A link for the Zoom session is available at EugeneEmComm.org.
9. Next Wednesday our regularly scheduled on-air net will return on this frequency at 7:00 PM.
10. I wish to thank all stations who checked in this evening for their participation. Thanks to LCSARO and W7ARD for providing emergency preparation leadership through Amateur Radio. Thank you to W7NK, the manager of this repeater, for the continued use of this repeater for use in emergency communication training and discussions. And thanks to those stations who stood by to give us a clear operating frequency for this net.
